Abstracts for contributed papers on research, outreach, or education submitted by members of SPS and their mentors are welcome. All abstracts must be submitted to AAPT electronically at <http://www.aapt.org/Events/abstractForm.cfm>.

After you have submitted your abstract to AAPT, send a request for a travel award to SPS by e-mailing a copy of your abstract to sps@aip.org by March 10th. Include the name, whether oral or poster presentation, mailing and e-mail address of the presenter, and social security number (for tax purposes).

A \$200 TRAVEL STIPEND will be awarded to the student presenters of the first 12 accepted abstracts (either oral or poster presentations). * The deadline for SPS abstracts is set two days ahead of the regular AAPT deadline. This is necessary to process travel awards. For additional information on the conference itself, consult the AAPT website: www.aapt.org/. Also, you must register for the meeting directly with AAPT.
