Application Guidelines for The Herbert Levy Memorial Endowment Fund Scholarship (\$2,000)

In memory of her late husband, Dr. Herbert Levy, Margaret Sussman Levy bequeathed funds to establish a scholarship award “to be used for a worthy, needy physics student” to attain a quality physics education.

To apply for the Levy Scholarship, please read carefully and follow the instructions on the Society of Physics Students Scholarship announcement and application form which precede this page, and make sure to do the following:

- 1) Using the SPS Leadership Scholarship Application Form, check the appropriate boxes on the scholarship application form; and
- 2) Be sure to include a statement of financial need.

The Levy Scholarship is open to any undergraduate physics student.

Application Guidelines for The SPS Future Teacher Scholarship (\$2,000)

To apply for the SPS Future Teacher Scholarship, please read carefully and follow the instructions on the Society of Physics Students Scholarship announcement and application form which precede this page. To apply for the Scholarship, do the following:

- 1) Using the SPS Leadership Scholarship Application Form, check the appropriate box on the scholarship application form; and
- 2) Be sure to include a statement from your advisor certifying your participation in a teacher education program.

The SPS Future Teacher Scholarship is open to any undergraduate physics student.

Application Guidelines for The Peggy Dixon Two-Year College Scholarship (\$2,000)

Based on scholarship, potential, and SPS participation, this award is intended for students who are transitioning from a two-year college into a physics bachelor’s degree program.

In determining the recipient(s), the SPS Scholarship Committee shall consider the following:

- 1) High scholarship performance both in physics and overall studies;
- 2) The exhibition of the potential and intention for continued scholastic development in physics; and
- 3) Active participation in SPS programs.

These three criteria are given equal weight.

Letters from at least two faculty members must be filed in support of your application as with all other SPS Scholarships. However, one of these letters must be from a current two-year physics faculty member familiar with you and your qualifications. Letters should comment on you in light of each of the three criteria to the extent possible.

To be eligible for this award a student must have completed at least one semester or quarter of the introductory physics sequence, and be currently registered in the appropriate subsequent physics courses.

The award will be granted in two equal installments, the first after satisfactory completion of the two-year college introductory physics sequence and the second after verification from the SPS advisor at the physics BS institution that at least one semester or quarter of appropriate physics courses has been completed.
